I am an out-of-the-box problem solver, with a significant history of successful executive leadership and consulting, primarily in systems for the compensation and support of people recovering from injury or illness. I have been successful in identifying cost and inefficiency drivers through understanding the interplay between large scale business processes, governmental regulation and human factors.

Recognition of emergent issues: I have obtained excellent outcomes through the early recognition of conflicts between divergent legal systems and identification of cost drivers, process bottlenecks and adverse environmental factors. This business intelligence allows organisations to proactively control business risk and policymakers to develop more enlightened interventions.
